

How much does it cost?

The cost of straightening teeth varies depending on the severity of your dental misalignment, the duration of the treatment and the type of correction you are looking for. The price of your personal Invisalign® treatment plan will be determined by your dentist, based on your specific needs.

The payments are usually spread out over a series of appointments.

At Brooklyn House our Invisalign costs are from £4,200.00

Keeping the aligners clean.

The best way to clean your aligners is by brushing and rinsing them in lukewarm water and using special cleaning tablets.

It's important that you brush your teeth after each meal before re-inserting your aligners to maintain good oral hygiene and removing any food residue.

Your responsibilities.

You must be committed to wearing the aligners for the prescribed time. The success of the treatment is dependant on your level of commitment.

What happens if I break or lose my aligners?

If you lose or break an Invisalign® aligner, immediately let your dentist know. Your Dentist will work with you to ensure you stay on-track with your treatment plan, which may involve wearing a previous set of aligners, your next set of aligners, or ordering replacements aligners.

Replacement aligners need to be ordered by your dentist as they are a prescription.



What happens at the end of my treatment?

Most Dentists recommend you wearing a retainer, once the treatment is complete, to prevent your teeth moving again.

This is something that can be discussed during the treatment process and usually is only worn at night for a period of time after treatment.

How does Invisalign® work?

Here is a step-by-step guide on the Invisalign® process:

Consultation: Book a consultation with our Invisalign trained dentist. They'll examine your smile, discuss your needs and recommend brace or aligner options. They may also use an intraoral scanner and take radiographs or photos in this appointment.

Making your aligners: A series of clear and removable aligners are custom-made to fit your mouth.

Receive your aligners: The dentist will ensure your aligners are comfortable and fit well. They'll let you know what to expect throughout treatment and can answer any questions.

Wear your aligners: You'll need to wear each set of aligners for 20-22 hours a day. You can remove them to eat, drink, brush and floss. Every four weeks, the dentist will check your treatment is progressing as planned.

Finish your treatment: Your treatment ends when you've worn each set of aligners. To maintain your straighter smile, you'll need to wear a retainer every night for a year, then usually a few nights a week, as instructed by your dentist.
